

Connect your Equipment

Using LAN Internet

1. Connect the router with your local internet using the blue port on the back of the router.




2. Connect the power adapter with the router and plug in to a power outlet




Push the button **IN** to turn ON the router.

Flip the switch to **ON** to turn ON the WiFi.



1. The indicator lights turn on and your device is ready to use
2. Your Rental devices are automatically connected to the Wireless network. If you need to add additional devices, you find the network name and password on the top of the router.
3. You can now connect printers or other devices using the additional Ethernet Outlets in the back of the Router marked with the numbers 1 to 4 or use the WPS button located on the back of the device to connect them.
4. Connect Wi-Fi devices using the WPS Button on the back of the Router. When you press the WPS button for 5 seconds, it allows you to use WPS for your Wi-Fi security. If pressed for longer than 5 seconds, the WPS will RESET the router back to factory default settings - The LED becomes quick-flash from slow-flash - Once button is released, the router will reboot to its factory default settings.



Please note: Some public internet providers (hotels or similar) require to login or accept their terms & conditions. Please connect a computer or tablet PC to the router (Wi-Fi or wired) and open an internet browser to test the connection or follow the instructions from the internet provider.
